

Scheduled as a fast-track summer renovation, the work was completed in just 10 weeks—ensuring the space was ready before students returned in the fall.

One of the paramount considerations throughout this endeavor was the minimization of disruptions to The Fessenden School's ongoing summer programs. Recognizing the importance of maintaining an active campus, Erland meticulously planned and executed each phase of the project with utmost care and precision, ensuring that students, campers, and staff could continue their activities without interference.
