The new 32,000sf, 2-story Science, Math & Library Center – built as an addition to the existing main building – features eight math classrooms; two biology labs; and two science classrooms on the first floor. The second floor houses two chemistry labs; two physics labs; a math/science computer room; a seminar room; and a reading room. A focal point of the new building is a large rotunda with high-end finishes that is used for physics lessons.

As part of this project, Erland renovated a section of the existing main building to allow connection with the new building. Life safety upgrades to St. Bartholomew's Church on the campus were also performed.
