During preconstruction, Erland and Bruner Cott worked with Brandeis University and the Rose Art Museum staff to set priorities for the museum renovations.

In the late 1990s, the museum added new (then state-of-the-art) gallery space. For this renovation, they upgraded the mechanical systems in the original building, built in 1961, to improve energy efficiency.

Renovations also included a new glazed vestibule in the lobby with glass railings and new lighting.



This project was completed to coincide with the Rose Art Museum's 50th anniversary celebration.
